

TEACHING OVERVIEW

We recognise church leaders will want to know a little more about what will be taught at this training course so we have created this overview detailing the aims and objectives, teaching content and practical skills that will be covered.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES

Our aim is that this training provides space for young people to dig deeper in understanding themselves and explore their leadership qualities. We aim to develop those qualities and prepare them for leadership, whether that be at MCYC this year, in their youth group at church or in any other setting they might find themselves in. Our objective is to take them on to the next level in leadership and encourage them to sign up to a week of MCYC and put their learning into action.

We want to provide training that prepares and equips them for a leadership role, no matter what level they are at, by enabling them to find their God-given gifts and know how most effectively to use them.

The weekend will cover several areas, both in theory, practical sessions and activities that help them discover the type of leader God wants them to be. From individual personality types, to how the bible shows us how Jesus led; this training is ideal for people who are looking at how to make an impact in their world.

TEACHING CONTENT

The sessions will contain teaching following the themes below alongside times of worship and prayer.

LEADING LIKE JESUS

What does the bible say about leadership? Leading like Jesus, following His example - 'Follow First'

INTRODUCTION TO LEADERSHIP

An introduction session looking at what leadership is, why it matters and considering good and bad leaders.



WHO AM I?

Learning about ourselves before working with and leading others

COMMUNICATION

Working with others and managing different characters. Communicating our story.

LEADING A BIBLE STUDY

A session considering what is needed to lead a Bible study, how to prepare and how to deliver.

DISCIPLESHIP

Considering what it means to disciple others - and be a disciple ourselves.

BUILDING HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS

Looking at how to form healthy and appropriate leader - camper relationships; being a good, friendly and supportive leader but within the confines of the role. We'll also look at working relationships with other leaders.

WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A LEADER

This session will be MCYC focussed considering what it takes to be a leader at camp, the different roles, and what is expected of you and what you can expect from us.

PRACTICAL SKILLS

Throughout the weekend and embedded in the sessions will be opportunities to develop a range of practical skills as detailed here.

ACTIVITIES

Planning and delivering a variety of sessions such as wet weather/ice breaker games, sports day game or similar.

SPEAKING

Public speaking training - an opportunity to speak in front of small groups in a safe environment to gain confidence. We hope to have a campfire with an opportunity to share testimonies.

WORSHIP LEADING

An opportunity to develop worship leading skills in a safe environment.

LEADING A BIBLE STUDY

An opportunity to plan and deliver a Bible study session.

SPIRITUAL GIFTS

We'll be looking at spiritual gifts and developing these in a scripturally based way.
